#### HAND SANITIZER

There is a great deal of discussion around hand hygiene at present.

Current recommendations are that washing your hands works best. When using hand sanitizers check that they are made from greater than 60% ethanol or 70% isopropanol. Remember you can only use hand sanitizer 2-3 times and then you must wash your hands. You can use a bleach solution for cleaning. Common household 4% chlorine bleach 25ml to 975ml water.
